<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take the James River Bridge (Route 17 - South) towards Isle of Wight County. • Take a right at the third stop light onto Route 32/258 (Brewers Neck Blvd) Travel 2.8 miles. • Take a right on <u>Route 10/258 (Benns Church Blvd)</u>. Travel 1.7 miles. • Bear right onto South Church Street 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take I-64 (Inner Loop) towards Suffolk. Merge onto I-664 North. • Take Exit 9A for the James River Bridge/Route 17. Stay on Route 17 North for about 8.9 miles. • Take a left onto <u>Route 32/258 (Brewers Neck Blvd)</u>. Travel 2.8 miles. • Take a right onto Route 10/258 (BennsChurchBlvd). Travel 1.7 miles. • Bear right onto South Church Street 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take Route 460. • When you get to Windsor, turn onto <u>Route 258 (Courthouse Highway) heading North</u>. Travel approx 14 miles. (<u>Courthouse Highway</u> will eventually turn into <u>Main Street</u> once you get within the town limits of Smithfield.) • Make a left onto South Church Street 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take <u>Route 10</u> East. • In Surry, make left on <u>Route 31</u>. • At stoplight, make right back onto <u>Route 10</u>. Follow Route 10 into Smithfield. Travel 16 miles. • Take a left at first stoplight onto <u>Main Street</u>. • Make a left onto South Church Street
